REGULATIONS

**on the organization and holding of V International Internet
Olympiad in English (IIOE - 2026) among the students of linguistic
and non-linguistic specialties of higher educational institutions of
Turkmenistan and abroad**

I. General regulations

1.1. This Regulation is a regulatory document for organizing and holding V International Internet Olympiad in English (IIOE - 2026) among the students of linguistic and non-linguistic specialties of higher educational institutions of Turkmenistan and abroad (hereinafter referred to as the Olympiad), it determines goal, task and procedure of holding it;

1.2. The Olympiad is held by Dovletmamet Azadi Turkmen National Institute of World Languages (hereinafter referred to as the Organizer) with the support of the Ministry of Education of Turkmenistan;

1.3. Organizational, methodological and technical support of the Olympiad is coordinated by the Organizer.

II. Goals and tasks of the Olympiad

2.1. Consolidation and improvement of theoretical and practical knowledge of students;

2.2. Raising their interest in learning English;

2.3. Checking the general level of English language proficiency and communication skills of students;

2.4. Developing the basic English language skills such as listening, speaking, writing and reading;

2.5. Expanding the scope of cooperation to promote foreign languages among the higher education institutions through the digital learning system;

2.6. Identifying talented youth in learning foreign languages and improving their skills.

III. Organizing and Jury Committee

3.1. Organizing and jury committee, consisting of the chairman, secretary and members of the committee, is approved by the Organizer;

3.2. Organizing committee determines the holding procedure, date, list of its participants of the qualifying round and Olympiad;

3.3. Jury committee determines the list of participants in the Olympiad based on the results of the qualifying round and the list of winners based on the results of the Olympiad;

3.4. Maintains contact with representatives of linguistic and non-linguistic specialties of higher educational institutions of Turkmenistan and abroad on the organization of the Olympiad.

IV. Participants of the Olympiad

4.1. The students of linguistic and non-linguistic specialties of higher educational institutions of Turkmenistan and abroad can participate in the Olympiad;

4.2. The number of participants is not limited;

4.3. Participation in the Olympiad is voluntary and free of charge;

4.4. By March 24, 2026, the student willing to participate in the Olympiad must fill out and submit the application form posted on the International Olympiad page of the Organizer's official website at datmddi.edu.tm;

4.5. Participant registration notification, user name and password will be sent to the email address specified in the application form (each participant should use a personal email address when registering).

V. The procedure for organizing and holding the Olympiad

5.1. In order to improve the organization of the Olympiad, on April 1-2, 2026, the qualifying round of the Olympiad will be held in higher educational institutions with simultaneous connection to the official website of the Organizer.

– The qualifying round will be held in the form of online testing and will be recorded via video. It is important that the video captures each participant's computer screen. Each participant must be provided with headphones;

– The test consists of 5 tasks related to reading, listening and grammar in English, for which 60 minutes are allotted;

– The participants must complete the test on their own;

- Each participant is given one opportunity to take the test;
 - The score obtained when passing the test is calculated automatically;
- 5.2. Jury committee determines the participants in the Olympiad based on the results of the test passed in the qualifying round.
- Of the total number of students who took part in the qualifying round, 30 percent of the students who received the highest scores will receive the right to participate in the Olympiad;
- 5.3. The Opening Ceremony of the Olympiad will be held on April 10, 2026, in the main conference hall of the institute. The participants from Turkmenistan will take in person; foreign participants will take an online participation in it. On April 10-11, 2026, the Olympiad will be held in the following order:
- The students of higher educational institutions of the country who are eligible to participate in the Olympiad will take part in it through the digital education system in the building of Dovletmammet Azadi Turkmen National Institute of World Languages;
 - The students of foreign universities who are eligible to participate in the Olympiad will participate online through the official website of the institute;
- 5.4. The Olympiad consists of 10 tasks related to reading, listening, writing, speaking and grammar in English, for which 90 minutes are allotted;
- The participants must complete the test on their own;
 - Each participant is given one opportunity to take the test;
 - The score obtained when passing the test is calculated automatically;
- 5.5. Jury committee determines the winners of the Olympiad based on the results of testing:
- 8 percent of students who took part in the Olympiad will be declared winners of the Olympiad;
- 5.6. The winners of the Olympiad will be awarded Diplomas of Dovletmammet Azadi Turkmen National Institute of World Languages and their list will be published on the official website of the institute on April 17, 2026;
