REGULATIONS

on the International Scientific and Practical Conference
“Global and National Experience in Foreign Language Teaching: Scientific Research and New Perspectives” digitally held with the participation of the lecturers, teachers, academic staff, doctoral candidates, and postgraduate students

In the Era of the Revival of the New Epoch of the Powerful State, in order to scientifically and methodologically analyse the activities aimed at the high-quality and comprehensive implementation of the large-scale reforms carried out within the framework of the education policy, including the introduction of innovative technologies in the field of science and education, the International Scientific and Practical Conference “Global and National Experience in Foreign Language Teaching: Scientific Research and New Perspectives” is being digitally held jointly with the Ministry of Education of Turkmenistan and on the basis of Dovletmamet Azadi Turkmen National Institute of World Languages, with the participation of the lecturers, teachers, academic staff, doctoral candidates, and postgraduate students.

The International Scientific and Practical Conference to be held digitally, “Global and National Experience in Foreign Language Teaching: Scientific Research and New Perspectives” (hereinafter referred to as the Conference) is a significant event that brings together leading scholars, educators, and researchers in the fields of linguistics and pedagogy. During the Conference, it is planned to discuss advanced approaches and new technologies in foreign language teaching that open new perspectives for the thorough and effective acquisition of the language skills. The Conference will provide participants with the favourable conditions to share their experience in foreign language teaching, to present the results of their scientific research and developments, as well as to discuss current trends and pressing issues in this field. Within the framework of the International Conference, the plenary meeting and thematic section meetings will be held, enabling participants to become closely acquainted with the latest developments in the methodology of foreign language teaching and with advanced international experience in this area.

The Conference will serve as an effective platform for strengthening professional relations among specialists in foreign languages from Turkmenistan and other countries, promoting mutual exchange of experience, establishing new international partnerships, and further consolidating traditionally established

cooperation. It will not be limited to reaffirming the importance of innovative teaching methods, but will also encourage the continuation of scientific research and the achievement of pedagogical excellence. Participation in the Conference will constitute another decisive step toward shaping a future in which language learning becomes more accessible, effective, and engaging for all educators and learners.

1. General Provisions

1.1. This Regulations defines the purpose, objectives, and procedure for holding the International Scientific and Practical Conference via a digital system, titled "Global and National Experience in Foreign Language Teaching: Scientific Research and New Perspectives" with the participation of the lecturers, teachers, academic staff, doctoral candidates, and postgraduate students.

1.2. The organizers of the Conference are the Ministry of Education of Turkmenistan and Dovletmammet Azadi Turkmen National Institute of World Languages.

1.3. The working languages of the Conference are Turkmen, English, and Russian.

2. Purpose and Objectives of the Conference

2.1. The purpose of the Conference is to generalize the advanced international experience of theoretical and practical studies on pressing issues related to the implementation of language teaching programs at all levels of education, and to widely demonstrate the successful implementation of the language policy in Turkmenistan.

2.2. The main objectives of the Conference:

– to discuss the main and future directions of examining language policy issues in the implementation of relevant state educational programs in the field of foreign languages;

– to exchange ideas and experience on improving approaches to foreign language teaching at all levels of education, as well as to identify the most effective practices in using innovative technologies in language teaching;

– to discuss the issues and determine future directions for the continued active use of advanced methodologies and modern digital technologies in foreign language teaching within the national education system;

– to promote scientific research, the achievements of national pedagogy, and the mastership traditions of the Turkmen people worldwide in the Era of the Revival of the New Epoch of the Powerful State;

– to assist in strengthening and expanding international cooperation between Turkmenistan's scientific community and professors, lecturers, teachers, and specialists of the foreign educational and research centers;

– to increase interest in the broad initiatives aimed at effectively improving educational programs under the leadership of the National Leader of the Turkmen People, Hero-Arkadag Gurbanguly Berdimuhamedov, and the esteemed President of Turkmenistan Serdar Berdimuhamedov, enriching them with new content in line

with the current requirements of the technological reforms in language teaching in Turkmenistan.

3. Conference work areas

3.1. Within the framework of the conference, it is planned to organize presentations on linguistics and linguistic didactics at the plenary meeting and in sections.

3.2. During the meeting, the speeches of local and foreign scientists and experts on the following issues will be heard:

- Achievements in the improvement of foreign language teaching in Turkmenistan;
- Linguistic and didactic principles of teaching languages;
- Modern methods and technologies of language teaching;
- International cooperation in foreign language teaching;
- Global and national experience of foreign language teaching;
- Tasks of language teaching methodologies within the framework of the Concept of Improving Teaching Methodologies in General Education Programs in Turkmenistan until 2028.

4. Participants of the conference and order of its work

4.1. The conference is open to the professors, lecturers and teachers of the higher and secondary vocational schools, teachers of the secondary comprehensive schools, researchers of the scientific and research institutions, postgraduate students, doctoral candidates, industry experts, specialists in linguistics and methods of foreign language teaching.

4.2. The conference will be held on April 23, 2026, which is declared as “Independent, Permanently Neutral Turkmenistan – the Homeland of Purposeful Winged Horses”.

4.3. To participate in the conference, participants must fill out the participant application form (hereinafter referred to as the Application) in the form specified in Appendix 1 by March 10, 2026 and send it to the organizing committee by e-mail ylym.datmddi@gmail.com. The theme of the letter: “TMDDI Maslahat. Familiya A.Aa. Sargyt” (“TNIWL Conference. Surname.N.P.Order”). The name of the attached file: “Sargyt_Familiya.docx” (“Order__Surname.docx”. Applications for the participation in the conference can also be submitted through the official website of the institute <https://www.datmddi.edu.tm/> in the relevant “Maslahat” (“Conference”) section.

4.4. Placing an order implies consent to the processing of personal data for the participation in the Conference.

4.5. To publish an abstract of the speech in the conference collection of abstracts, you must fill out the application form in the form specified in Appendix 1. The abstract of the speech for the publication in the collection must be prepared in accordance with the requirements of Section 6 of these Regulations, according to

the form in Appendix 2. The file with the application form and the file with the thesis of the speech must be sent to the organizing committee by e-mail no later than March 10, 2026 at ylym.datmddi@gmail.com. The theme of the letter: "TMDDI Maslahat. Familiya A.Aa. Gysgaça beýan" ("TNIWL Conference. Surname N.P. Abstract"). The name of the attached file: "Gysgaça beýan_Familiya.docx" ("Abstract_Surname.docx").

4.6. The following time limit is set for the speeches of the conference participants: speech at the plenary meeting - 15 minutes, speech at the meeting of the sections - up to 7 minutes.

4.7. The speeches of the participants in the sections can be combined with multimedia presentations in PPTX or PDF format without any limitation on the number of slides, but they must be in accordance with the time limit of the speeches. The multimedia presentation must be in one format according to the sample provided in the relevant section of the institute's website.

4.8. Based on the results of the conference, it is planned to publish a collection of abstracts of the speeches, which will be registered in RINS (Russian Index of Scientific Reference) (with an ISBN) and placed on the website of the "Scientific Electronic Library" (E-library), on the website of Dovletmamet Azadi Turkmen National Institute of World Languages, and also sent to all participants of the conference.

4.9. Within two weeks after the end of the conference, all participants will be sent the certificate of participation via the email address specified in the Order.

5. Expected results

5.1. Best practices and best methodological frameworks in foreign language teaching will be discussed and analyzed, and best practices will be generalized, allowing for the introduction of proven methods and approaches into the national education system.

5.2. A sequence of introducing the new methods will be developed: innovative methods and technologies for foreign language teaching that will increase the effectiveness of educational work will be created and tested.

5.3. The professional level of educators will be improved: Conference participants will be able to improve their professional skills by learning leading pedagogical practices and approaches.

5.4. International scientific relations will be strengthened: cooperation between scientists, specialists, and educators from the different countries, which will promote the exchange of experience and joint scientific work, will be established and strengthened.

5.5. Scientific works will be published: The results of scientific researches and innovative approaches presented at the conference will be published in the scientific publications, which will ensure their accessibility in the wide scientific and educational space.

5.6. Knowledge resources will be created: new learning materials and resources will be created and disseminated to help improve foreign language teaching.

5.7. Digital tools will be developed: modern digital tools and platforms will be introduced that facilitate language learning and make it more active and accessible.

5.8. Scientific researches will be encouraged: experts will be drawn to the importance of the scientific researches in language education and pedagogy, which will encourage new scientific researches and experimentation.

5.9. Distance learning methodologies will be improved: distance learning methodologies for foreign languages will be introduced and improved, making learning more flexible and accessible to the different groups of learners.

5.10. Educational innovations will be supported: assistance will be provided to develop and implement innovative projects and programs aimed at improving the methodologies of foreign language teaching and improving the quality of education in this field.

6. Requirements for Preparing Abstracts of Speeches

6.1. For the publication in the conference collection, abstracts of speeches relevant to the conference topics are accepted, whether prepared individually or jointly, with a length of 2.5-3 pages.

6.2. The languages accepted for the publication of abstracts in the collection are English and Russian.

6.3. Materials are published in the author's own editorial version. Authors bear full responsibility for the academic and scholarly quality of the published material. All submitted materials are checked using the Antiplagiarism software, and only those with an originality rate of not less than 80% are accepted for the publication in the collection.

6.4. Abstracts must be submitted in DOCX format and formatted according to the following specifications: A4 paper size, portrait orientation, margins of 2 cm on all sides.

6.5. At the beginning of the abstract, the title, information about the author(s), the abstract in English and Russian, and keywords must be provided (see Appendix 2).

6.5.1. UDC (Universal Decimal Classification) must be indicated in the upper left corner of the abstract.

6.5.2. After one line space, the title of the abstract must be typed in the capital letters, in bold, and centered.

6.5.3. After one line space, the surname, first name, and patronymic of the author(s) must be written in full, in bold italics, and right-aligned.

6.5.4. On the next line, the academic degree and academic title (if any), and position of the author(s) must be indicated in italics.

6.5.5. On the next line, the full name of the institution followed by the country must be indicated in italics.

6.5.6. After one line space, the abstract text (400–500 characters including spaces) must be justified.

6.5.7. On the next line, 8-10 keywords must be provided, justified.

6.6. The abstract text and keywords in both languages must be typed in Times New Roman, italicized, font size 12 pt, justified, with single line spacing.

6.7. The main text of the abstract must be typed in Times New Roman, font size 14 pt, justified, with 1.5 line spacing, and a paragraph indent of 1.25 cm (spaces and the “Tab” key must not be used).

6.8. The text in tables must be typed in Times New Roman, font size 12 pt.

6.8.1. The table number and title must be placed above the table and centered.

6.8.2. Tables must not be inserted as graphic objects.

6.8.3. References to tables in the text must be formatted as follows: (tabl. 1.5)

6.9. Any graphic objects used (figures, photographs, etc.) must be of high quality and placed in the center of the page.

6.9.1. The figure number and title must be placed below the figure and centered.

6.9.2. References to figures in the text must be given as “(Fig. 1)” or mentioned in the text (e.g. “The results are shown in Figure 1”).

6.9.3. The list of references must consist of sources arranged in alphabetical order.

6.9.4. Bibliographic entries in the reference list must be typed in Times New Roman, font size 14 pt, and justified.

6.9.5. Citations in the text must be given in square brackets, for example: [3, p. 129]. The first number indicates the source number in the reference list, and the second indicates the page number.

6.10. Abstracts that do not comply with the formatting requirements will not be accepted for the publication.
